# INVITATION

## Lake Macquarie Bi-Annual Sculpture Acquisition Prize

Lake Macquarie City Art Gallery is staging its first Bi-Annual Sculpture Acquisition Prize.

Sculptors are invited to submit concept drawings to be considered by the selection panel, by 13th August 1996.

From the initial concept drawings, twenty artists will be selected to exhibit finished drawings and maquettes at the new Lake Macquarie City Art Gallery in Awaba House, Booragul.

From the twenty works on show, the winner will be selected by Tony Bond, Head Curator of Western Art, Art Gallery of New South Wales. Also the Gallery's Acquisition Committee will select one work. Both of the successful artists will then be commissioned to make the sculptures.

The selected works, when completed, will become a permanent part of the Lake Macquarie City Collection and will be situated in the grounds of the Lake Macquarie City Art Gallery at Awaba House.

# CONDITIONS of entry

1. All entries must be the original work of the artist/artists.
2. Entries must be based on the theme of 'water' (open to loose interpretation).
3. Entries must be lodged by 4pm on 13 August 1996. Entries include
  - (a) Entry form
  - (b) Artist's C.V.
  - (c) Concept drawings (materials etc.)
4. Entries will be viewed by the selection panel and successful entrants will be notified by 16 August.
5. Finished and framed drawings together with high quality maquettes to be delivered to Lake Macquarie City Art Gallery, 143-147 Main Road, Speers Point. NSW. 2284 by the 25 September 1996.
6. The selected works will be exhibited in the Lake Macquarie City Art Gallery, Awaba House from 28 September to 3 November, 1996. No selected entries will be removed from the exhibition before its completion.
7. The selected two sculptures must be completed and insitu by 1 February 1997. The \$10,000 commission for each sculpture is all inclusive (materials, labour etc.). Staged payments and contracts will be negotiated.
8. The commissioned sculptures will be displayed in the grounds of the Awaba House Gallery and therefore should not pose a safety risk to the public and should be suitable for permanent, public, outdoor display in both materials and structure.
9. The two commissioned sculptures, the maquettes and drawings will become the property of the Lake Macquarie City Council.
