

FISHER'S GHOST SCULPTURE AS GIANT WEATHER-VANE

- \* TOP-HALF OF SCULPTURE ABOVE WAIST IS THE ROTATING WEATHER-VANE. ONE ARM BECKONING, THE OTHER POINTING INTO THE WIND. LEGS IN FIXED POSITION.
- \* FIGURE HEIGHT ca. 5 m, MOUNTED ON SUPPORT POLE WITH GHOST'S FOOT 5 - 8 m ABOVE GROUND LEVEL (TOTAL HEIGHT ca. 10 - 13 m).
- \* CENTRAL SUPPORT AXIS IS GALVANISED OR STAINLESS STEEL PIPE MOUNTED IN CONCRETE BASE (AS PER EXPRESSWAY LIGHTS) AND EXTENDS TO TOP SHOULDER.
- \* ROTATING AXIS IS MOUNTED BY BALL-BEARINGS ON CENTRAL SUPPORT. BEARINGS ARE PROTECTED FROM WEATHER.
- \* WEATHER-VANE PART IS MOUNTED TO A HORIZONTAL PIPE (FLEXED TO SHAPE OF POINTING ARM) FIXED TO THE ROTATING AXIS.
- \* MATERIAL: ANODIZED ALUMINIUM SHEETING (WELDED)  
JACKET: PLUM COLOUR  
REMAINDER: SILVER
- \* EERIE SOUND-EFFECTS CREATED BY WIND BLOWING THROUGH THE SHAPED HOLES IN THE FIXED PART OF THE SCULPTURE AND ALSO ACROSS BENT ENDS OF HOLLOW HORIZONTAL PIPE IN ROTATING PART (ORGAN-PIPE EFFECT).
- \* AT NIGHT - EFFECT WILL BE OF A GHOSTLY, MOVING SILHOUETTE. BY DAY - METAL WILL GLISTEN IN SUN AND PLUM-COLOURED JACKET WILL GLOW.
- \* SCULPTURE IS DESIGNED TO BE AS VANDAL-PROOF AS POSSIBLE, WEATHER-RESISTANT AND REQUIRING MINIMUM MAINTENANCE.
- \* SHAPES CAN BE MODIFIED TO SOLVE ENGINEERING PROBLEMS.
